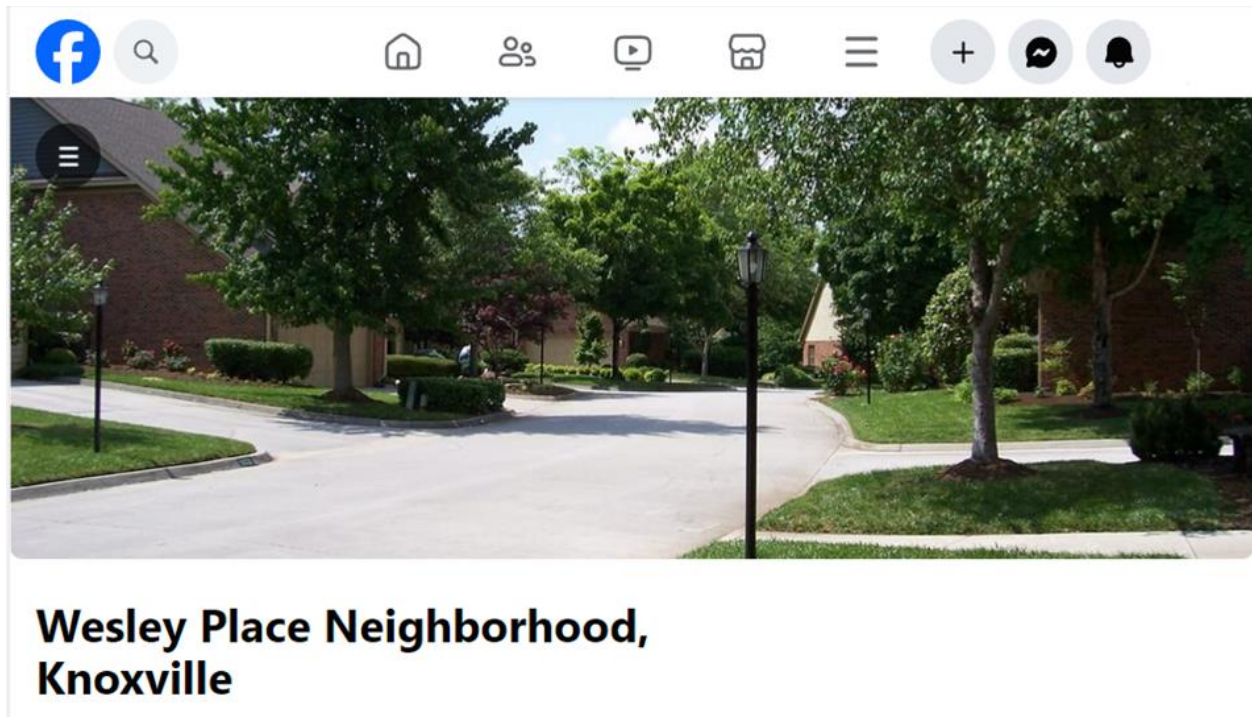

Wesley Place Private Site

HOA Management's Frontsteps system (<https://wesleyplace.frontsteps.com>) is where Wesley Place's private information can be found. This site allows you to pay dues, review the FAQs, see your ACC and maintenance request history, and find Wesley Place documents that are not available to the public, such as:

- Frequently asked questions (FAQ)
- Board minutes
- Financial reports
